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The staff of the Enforcement Unit of the Registration & Enforcement Section of the Division of Securities alleges that:

1. Great Basin Petroleum, Inc. ("GBP") is a foreign business entity with a last known business address of 10 West 100 South, #425, Salt Lake City, UT 84101.
2. Crawford Gas Well Partners ("Crawford") is a foreign business entity with a last known business address of 10 West 100 South, #425, Salt Lake City, UT 84101.
3. Kevin G. Harley (DOB 1/29/63; CRD # 2435178) ("Harley") is an individual who at all times material hereto has been President and a Director of GBP, with a last known business address at that of GBP.
4. Scott J. Hoonakker (DOB 12/7/69; CRD #2325915) ("Hoonakker") is an individual who at all times material hereto has been Secretary and a Director of GBP, with a last known business address of 200 North 63 East, Salt Lake City, UT 84103.
5. Frank P. Turner ("Turner") is an individual who at all times material hereto has been a Director of GBP, with a last known business address at that of 1807 East 1700 South, Salt Lake City, UT 84108.
6. R. Frederick Morrow ("Morrow") is an individual who at all times material hereto has been an agent of GBP, Crawford, Harley, Hoonakker and Turner, with a last known business address at that of GBP.
7. During the period of 1996 and 1997, unknown agents, on behalf of GBP, Crawford, Harley, Hoonakker and Turner, offered and sold to at least eleven persons in Wisconsin fractional, undivided working interests in an oil, gas, or mining title or lease or in payments out of production under such title or lease.
8. During the period of November, 1997, Morrow, on behalf of GBP, Crawford, Harley, Hoonakker and Turner, offered to at least one person in Wisconsin fractional, undivided working interests in an oil, gas, or mining title or lease or in payments out of production under such title or lease.
9. The interests in oil and gas wells offered by the respondents are securities as defined by sec. 551.02(13), Wis. Stats., and have never been registered for offer and sale in Wisconsin pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.
10. All Respondents have violated sec. 551.21(1), Wis. Stats., by offering unregistered securities in Wisconsin.

11. In connection with the offers of the securities described above, Morrow transacted business in Wisconsin as an "agent" for GBP, Crawford, Harley, Hoonakker and Turner, as that term is defined by sec. 551.02(2), Wis. Stats.
12. At no time has Morrow been licensed as a securities agent pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.
13. Morrow has violated sec. 551.31(1), Wis. Stats., by transacting business in Wisconsin as a securities agent without a license.
14. GBP, Crawford, Harley, Hoonakker and Turner have violated sec. 551.31(2), Wis. Stats., by employing an unlicensed agent to represent them in Wisconsin.
15. On January 20, 1998, the State of Texas Securities Board entered an Order against GBP, based on allegations of securities law violations.

Therefore, the staff of the Enforcement Unit petitions the Administrator of the Division of Securities for the issuance of the attached Order pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.
