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The staff of the Enforcement Unit, Registration & Enforcement Section of the Division of Securities, Department of Financial Institutions, State of Wisconsin, has conducted an investigation in this matter pursuant to sec. 551.56, Wis. Stats., and as a result thereof alleges as follows:

1. Force Tek, Inc. ("Force") is a foreign business entity with a last known business address of 3190 Airport Loop, Building F., Costa Mesa, California 92705.
2. Chandler Hooper ("Hooper") is an individual who at all times material hereto has been a salesperson for Force, with a last known business address as that of Force.
3. Nick Garcia ("Garcia") is an individual who at all times material hereto has been a salesperson for Force, with a last known business address as that of Force.
4. During approximately June or July of 1997, Hooper and Garcia offered to at least one person in Wisconsin an investment in Force a/k/a/ Force Technologies, Inc. and Force Technologies, a company that allegedly develops, manufactures and sells a broad spectrum of unique patented and proprietary products such as HIV test procedures, clear defense safety and security films and laminates and internet casino offerings.
5. On July 15, 1997, the person in Wisconsin sent a check in the amount of \$5,000 payable to Force Tek, Inc. to Hooper for the purpose of investing in 487 shares of Force.
6. The stock described in paragraphs 4 and 5 above is a security as defined in sec. 551.02(13)(a), Wis. Stats.
7. The security described above has never been registered nor exempt from registration for offer and sale in Wisconsin pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.
8. All Respondents have violated sec. 551.21(1), Wis. Stats., by offering and selling unregistered securities in Wisconsin.
9. In connection with the offers of the securities described above, Hooper and Garcia transacted business in Wisconsin as "agents" for Force, as that term is defined by sec. 551.02(2), Wis. Stats.
10. At no time material hereto were Hooper and Garcia licensed as securities agents in Wisconsin pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.
11. Force has violated sec. 551.31(2), Wis. Stats., by employing unlicensed agents to represent them in Wisconsin.

12. Hooper and Garcia have violated sec. 551.31(1), Wis. Stats., by transacting business in Wisconsin as securities agents without licenses.
13. Upon information and belief, the offering materials provided to the Wisconsin investor by Hooper portrayed the company as a viable entity that was endorsed by a Wall Street Research Report.
14. Hooper and Garcia failed to disclose that Force was not connected in any way with the documentation of Force Technologies, Inc., a Canadian company located at Suite 970, 789 West Pender Street, Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada V6C 1H2 trading in Canada on the Toronto Stock Exchange that was provided to the person in Wisconsin.
15. By engaging in the conduct described above respondents have made an untrue statement of a material fact or omitted to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they are made, not misleading to a person in Wisconsin, contrary to sec. 551.41(2), Wis. Stats.

Therefore, the staff of the Enforcement Unit petitions the Administrator of the Division of Securities for issuance of the attached order pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.
