The staff of the State of Wisconsin, Department of Financial Institutions, Division of Securities, Bureau of Registration & Enforcement, has conducted an investigation in this matter pursuant to sec. 551.56, Wis. Stats., and as a result thereof alleges as follows:

1. The Sci-Fi Megaplex, Inc. (dba The Original Sci-Fi Café & Emporium, Inc.) (hereinafter referred to as "Sci-Fi, Inc.") is, upon information and belief, a business entity incorporated in the State of Florida, with a last known business address of 1132 SE 2nd Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33316;
2. Glenn K. Jackson (hereinafter referred to as "Jackson") is an adult male individual who, upon information and belief, is approximately 37 years old, was a founder of Sci-Fi, Inc. and at all times material hereto a director, officer and a controlling person of Sci-Fi, Inc., with a last known business address at that of Sci-Fi, Inc.;
3. Raymond J. Talarico (hereinafter referred to as "Talarico") is an adult male individual who upon information and belief, is approximately 41 years old, was a founder of Sci-Fi, Inc. and at all times material hereto a director, officer and a controlling person of Sci-Fi, Inc., with a last known business address at that of Sci-Fi, Inc. and a last known home address of 719 SE 12 Ct., Ft. Lauderdale, Florida 33316;
4. Gerald J. "Jay" Stock (hereinafter referred to as "Stock") is an adult male individual who at all times material hereto has represented Sci-Fi, Inc., Jackson and Talarico in offering and selling securities of Sci-Fi, Inc. to a person in Wisconsin as described hereinafter, with a last known home address at at 851 Summit Street, Manitowoc, Wisconsin 54220;
5. Stock has a date of birth of January 1, 1967, was previously licensed as a securities agent by the Division of Securities from 1993 to 1999, and has a CRD number of 2369601;
6. Upon information and belief, during the period of at least 1999, Stock on behalf of Sci-Fi, Inc., Jackson and Talarico, offered and sold to at least one person in Wisconsin shares of common stock of Sci-Fi, Inc.;
7. The shares of common stock of Sci-Fi, Inc. are "securities" as that term is defined and used in Ch. 551, Wis. Stats., the Wisconsin Uniform Securities Law;
8. In connection with the offers and sales of the securities described above, Stock transacted business in Wisconsin as a securities "agent" for Sci-Fi, Inc., Jackson and Talarico, as that term is defined by sec. 551.02(2), Wis. Stats.;
9. Upon information and belief, Stock's employing broker-dealer at the time did not approve the offer and/or sale of the common stock of Sci-Fi, Inc. by Stock;

NOTICE:

Under sec. 551.61(2), Wis. Stats., within thirty (30) days after any Order has become effective without a hearing, any interested party may file a written request with the Administrator of the Division of Securities for a hearing in respect to any matters determined by the Order. A request for hearing shall be in the form of a petition for hearing and shall, under section SEC 8.01, Wis. Adm. Code, plainly admit or deny each specific allegation, finding, or conclusion in the Order and incorporated papers (unless the petitioner lacks sufficient knowledge or information to permit an admission or denial, in which case the petition shall so state, and such statement shall have the effect of a denial), and shall state all affirmative defenses.


You are advised that any willful violation of an Order issued by the Administrator of the Division of Securities of the State of Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions under Ch. 551, Wis. Stats., is a criminal offense punishable under the provisions of sec. 551.58, Wis. Stats.

10. Pursuant to DFI-Sec 4.06(2), Wis. Adm. Code, effecting any securities transaction not recorded on the regular books or records of the broker-dealer which the agent represents is deemed a "dishonest or unethical business practice" or "taking unfair advantage of a customer" by an agent, which provides a basis for the censure of a licensee pursuant to §551.34(1)(g), Wis. Stats., unless the transaction is disclosed to and authorized in writing by the broker-dealer prior to the execution of the transaction;

11. Sci-Fi, Inc., Jackson, and Talarico have violated sec. 551.31(2), Wis. Stats., by employing an agent not licensed by them to represent them in Wisconsin; and

12. The staff of the Division of Securities mailed letters of inquiry, concerning the matters referenced herein, to Sci-Fi, Inc., Jackson, Talarico, and Stock on June 4, 2002 and have not received the information requested.

Therefore, the staff of the Bureau of Registration & Enforcement petitions the Administrator of the Division of Securities for the issuance of the attached Order pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.

AND REVOCATION
(SUMMARY)

Based upon the attached Petition for Order I have reason to believe that a security has been offered or sold in Wisconsin by an unlicensed person in violation of Ch. 551, Wis. Stats., and I find that this action is necessary and appropriate in the public interest and for the protection of investors;

Therefore, pursuant to secs. 551.24(2), 551.60(2)(b) and 551.63, Wis. Stats.,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- a. The Sci-Fi Megaplex, Inc. (dba The Original Sci-Fi Café & Emporium, Inc.), its successors, affiliates, controlling persons, officers, agents, servants, employees, and every entity and person directly or indirectly controlled or organized by or on its behalf, are prohibited from making or causing to be made to any person or entity in Wisconsin any further offers or sales of securities unless and until such securities are registered under Ch. 551, Wis. Stats., or successor statute.
- b. All exemptions from registration set forth at Ch. 551, Wis. Stats., or successor statute, that might otherwise apply to any offer or sale of any security of or by The Sci-Fi Megaplex, Inc. (dba The Original Sci-Fi Café & Emporium, Inc.), its successors, affiliates, controlling persons, and every entity and person directly or indirectly controlled or organized by or on its behalf, are hereby revoked.
- c. The Sci-Fi Megaplex, Inc. (dba The Original Sci-Fi Café & Emporium, Inc.), its successors, affiliates, controlling persons, officers, agents, servants, employees, and every entity and person directly or indirectly controlled or hereafter organized by or on its behalf, are prohibited from employing an agent to represent them in Wisconsin unless the agent is licensed under Ch. 551, Wis. Stats., or successor statute, or excepted from the licensing requirement.
