


The staff of the Enforcement Unit, Registration & Enforcement Section, of the Division of Securities, Department of Financial Institutions, State of Wisconsin has conducted an investigation in this matter pursuant to sec. 551.56, Wis. Stats. and as a result thereof alleges as follows:

1. Bytesize Computers, Inc, (“Bytesize Computers”) is a business entity with a last known address of 421 Fourth Street, Mosinee, Wisconsin 54455.
2. Glynn W. DeLange (“DeLange”) is an individual who at all time material hereto has been “President” of Bytesize Computers.
3. DeLange is an individual with a date-of-birth of 11/22/66 and a last known home address of 642 County Road B, Mosinee, Wisconsin 54455.
4. During the period of January 12, 2002, to December 31, 2002, on behalf of Bytesize Computers, DeLange offered to at least two persons in Wisconsin the opportunity to make a “business loan” to Bytesize Computers.
5. The oral indebtedness contracts offered by the respondents are a security as defined by sec. 551.02(13), Wis. Stats.
6. In connection with the offer and sale of the security described in Paragraph 4 above, the Respondents made untrue statements of material facts as follows: Bytesize Computers was the only computer shop in Marathon County and Portage County that offered in-home repair and support to the general everyday person, and that Bytesize Computers handled the web construction for Linehan Law Office and Gallagher Chiropractic.
7. All Respondents have violated sec.551.41(2), Wis. Stats., by making an untrue statement of material fact in the offer and sale of securities to persons in Wisconsin.
8. In connection with the offer and sale of a security described in Paragraph 4 above, the Respondents omitted to state material facts including but not limited to the following: The large number of unpaid money judgments against DeLange, and the past criminal record of DeLange.
9. All Respondents have violated sec. 551.41(2), Wis. Stats., by omitting to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading, in connection with the offer and sale of securities to persons in Wisconsin.

Therefore, the staff of the Enforcement Unit petitions the Administrator of the Division of Securities for the issuance of the attached Order pursuant to Ch. 551, Wis. Stats.
