The staffs of the Licensing & Compliance Section and the Enforcement Unit, Registration & Enforcement Section, of the Division of Securities, Department of Financial Institutions, State of Wisconsin have conducted an investigation in this matter pursuant to sec. 551.56, Wis. Stats., and as a result thereof allege as follows:


1. Ronald G. Richer ("Richer") is a securities agent (CRD #2988381) with a last known business address of 230 Park Avenue, Suite 934, New York, NY 10004 and last known residential address of 65 Seamen Avenue, New York, NY 10034;
2. Westrock Advisors, Inc. ("Westrock") is a securities broker-dealer (CRD #114338) licensed in Wisconsin since March 19, 2002 with a last known business address of 230 Park Avenue, Suite 934, New York, NY 10004;
3. On January 7, 2005, Richer applied through the CRD to become licensed as a securities agent in Wisconsin for Westrock;
4. By letter dated January 11, 2005, the staff sent a letter to Westrock with a copy to Richer requesting additional information regarding Richer's disclosure history. The response date was February 1, 2005. No response was received to this request for information;
5. On February 15, 2005, the staff sent another letter to Westrock with a copy to Richer requesting additional information regarding Richer's disclosure history. The response deadline was March 7, 2005. No response was received to this request for information;
6. On April 11, 2005, the staff sent a letter by certified mail to Westrock and to Richer advising the firm to withdraw Richer's application by May 2, 2005 for failure to respond to the staff's requests for information;
7. To date the staff has not received any information from Westrock or Richer nor has Richer's application been withdrawn;
8. Richer's failure to complete his application, as described above, provides a basis, pursuant to sec. 551.34(1)(a), Wis. Stats., for the denial of his application.

THEREFORE, the staffs of the Licensing & Compliance Section and the Enforcement Unit petition the Administrator for the issuance of the attached Order.
