PETITION FOR ORDER

The staffs of the Licensing & Compliance Bureau and the Registration & Enforcement Bureau, of the Division of Securities, Department of Financial Institutions, State of Wisconsin have conducted an investigation in this matter pursuant to sec. 551.56, Wis. Stats., and as a result thereof allege as follows:


1. Robert R. Wilkos ("Wilkos") is a securities agent (CRD #3127146) with a last known business address of 50 Broad Street, Suite 1401, New York, NY 10004 and last known residential address of 68 Gunton Place, Staten Island, NY 10309;
2. Great Eastern Securities, Inc. ("GES") is a securities broker-dealer (CRD #2061) licensed in Wisconsin since October 10, 2000 with a last known business address of 50 Broad Street, Suite 1401, New York, NY 10004;
3. On October 4, 2005, Wilkos applied through the CRD to become licensed as a securities agent in Wisconsin for GES;
4. By letter dated October 5, 2005, the staff sent a letter to GES with a copy to Wilkos requesting additional information regarding Wilkos' disclosure history. The response due date was October 26, 2005. No response was received to this request for information;
5. On October 27, 2005, the staff sent another letter to GES with a copy to Wilkos requesting additional information regarding Wilkos' disclosure history. The response deadline was November 10, 2005. No response was received to this request for information;
6. On November 14, 2005, the staff sent a letter by certified mail to GES and to Wilkos advising the firm to withdraw Wilkos' application by November 21, 2005 for failure to respond to the staff's requests for information;
7. To date the staff has not received any information from GES or Wilkos nor has Wilkos' application been withdrawn;
8. Wilkos' failure to complete his application, as described above, provides a basis, pursuant to sec. 551.34(1)(a), Wis. Stats., for the denial of his application.

THEREFORE, the staffs of the Licensing & Compliance Bureau and the Registration & Enforcement Bureau petition the Administrator for the issuance of the attached Order.
