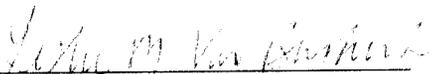

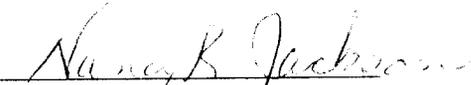
The staff of the Bureau of Registration & Enforcement and the Bureau of Licensing and Compliance of the Division of Securities, Department of Financial Institutions, State of Wisconsin, has conducted an investigation into this matter pursuant to §551.56, Wisconsin Statutes, and as a result thereof alleges as follows:

1. The respondent Christopher Lee Jacke ("Jacke") (CRD # 3041945) is an individual who, at all times material hereto, was employed as a securities agent with Packerland Brokerage Services, Inc. ("Packerland"). He conducted business as a principal of Protective Financial Solutions, located at 2120 Ridge Road, Green Bay, Wisconsin. His last known address is 1711 Edgehill Drive, Green Bay, Wisconsin 54304.
2. On November 21, 2006, the NASD fined Jacke \$10,000 and suspended him from association with any NASD member in any capacity for two months (commencing December 4, 2006 through February 3, 2007), required him to requalify as a general securities representative, and required "pre-use" filing of all future advertising for a two-year period pursuant to an Acceptance, Waiver and Consent Order.
3. The basis for the November 21, 2006 Acceptance, Waiver and Consent Order was NASD staff allegations that Jacke had violated NASD rules 2210(c)(2) and 2210(d)(1)(A)-(C), which is deemed to be a "dishonest and unethical business practice" pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code. DFI-Sec. §4.02(2)(i), and provides a basis for the suspension of a securities agent's license pursuant to Wis. Stats. §551.34(1)(g). Most of the advertisements in violation of NASD rules targeted Wisconsin residents and were circulated in Wisconsin.

THEREFORE, the staff of the Bureau of Licensing & Compliance and the Bureau of Registration & Enforcement petition the Administrator for the issuance of an Order of Suspension of Jacke's securities agent license for two months to run concurrently with the NASD Order of November 21, 2006.
