- a. Leonard E. Dunn is hereby suspended for transacting discretionary trading in a customer's account without prior written discretionary authority from the customer as proscribed by DFI-Sec. 4.06(2)(i), Wis. Adm. Code and §551.34(1)(g), Wis. Stats.; and
- b. The securities agent license of Leonard E. Dunn is hereby suspended for a period of ten business days to be served on February 18, 2008 through February 29, 2008.
