Aircraft factory, amusement park proposed for Franklin

Two unique projects — an aircraft factory and a Christian-themed amusement park — from the same applicant have been proposed for the city of Franklin.

The proposals were submitted by Cindy Drehmel, who lists herself as managing director of Freedom Air LLC and God's People United LLC.

"This is very early and very initial," said Joel Dietl, planning manager for the city of Franklin.

Franklin's Community Development Authority was expected to discuss the new business development proposals at a Sept. 23 meeting.

"We have to determine if these proposals are feasible," Franklin Mayor Tom Taylor said. "We'll have open ears, but we're prepared to do our due diligence."

Drehmel has inquired about potential incentives available from the city designed to attract new businesses.

Deitl and Taylor said the city rarely has offered major financial incentives to companies looking to build in Franklin. Incentives have been provided to major projects such as Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Co., Wheaton Franciscan Healthcare-Franklin and Harley-Davidson Inc.

Drehmel's proposal for an aircraft manufacturing facility is one the city "might not want to dismiss" without a more in-depth review, Taylor said.
