Therefore, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 551.604,


IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent Rhiannon Lee Cupkie (CRD# 4537185), and any successors, affiliates, and every entity directly or indirectly controlled or organized by or on her behalf, is hereby prohibited from making or causing to be made to any person or entity in Wisconsin any offers or sales of securities;
2. All exemptions from registration that might otherwise apply to any offer or sale of any securities of or by Rhiannon Lee Cupkie and any successors, affiliates, controlling persons, officers, agents, servants, employees, and every entity or person directly or indirectly controlled or organized by or on his behalf, are hereby revoked;
3. Rhiannon Lee Cupkie is prohibited from registering with the State of Wisconsin Division of Securities as a securities professional, including but not limited to investment adviser, investment adviser representative, broker-dealer agent, and agent for issuer.

This Order consented to by the Respondent prohibits Respondent from transacting securities business in the State of Wisconsin, effective upon the date issued, and shall have the same effect on Respondent as a permanent injunction entered by a circuit court pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 551.603(2)(a).
