

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that this Summary Order is effective on the date it is issued. You are advised that any willful violation of an Order issued by the Division under Wis. Stats. Ch. 551 is a criminal offense punishable under the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 551.508 (2013-14).

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that you have a right to request a hearing on the matters set forth in the Summary Order as set forth in Wis. Stat. §551.61(2).¹ Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code DFI § 8.01, any request for a hearing must be in the form of a written petition filed with the Division within 30 days after the date of service of this Notice and Summary Order. A petition for a hearing to review an order shall:

(1) Plainly admit or deny each specific allegation, finding, or conclusion in the Order and any incorporated papers. However, if the petitioner lacks sufficient knowledge or information to permit an admission or denial, the petition shall so state, and that statement shall have the effect of a denial. Any allegation, finding, or conclusion that is not denied shall be deemed admitted; and

(2) State all affirmative defenses. Affirmative defenses not raised in the request for hearing may be deemed waived.

ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST
(SUMMARY)

File No. S-230624 (EX)

The Administrator of the State of Wisconsin, Department of Financial Institutions, Division of Securities ("the Division"), having authority to administer and provide for enforcement of the Wisconsin Uniform Securities Law, Wis. Stats. Chapter 551, ("WUSL"), and having determined that this action is necessary and appropriate in the public interest and for the protection of investors, hereby enters this Order directing Respondents to immediately Cease and Desist from violating the WUSL.

Based upon the evidence obtained by the Division's Bureau of Enforcement, there are grounds sufficient for the Administrator to make the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

RESPONDENTS

1. Premier Funding & Investment, LLC ("Premier") was organized as a Wisconsin limited liability company on April 14, 2003, but became delinquent in April 2009 and was administratively dissolved on November 9, 2011. David James Lambert was its registered agent and manager. Its last known business address was 15756 93rd Street, Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin 54729.
2. David J. Lambert, ("Lambert") is an adult born in July 1975, who at all times material hereto has been the promoter and manager of Premier, with a last known address at 15756 93rd Street, Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin 54729.

FINDINGS OF FACT

3. In 2006 through 2007, Lambert offered an opportunity to investment in promissory notes of Premier to be repaid in one year with 20% interest to at least three people in Wisconsin.
4. In connection with the offers and sales of the promissory notes of Premier to the Wisconsin investors, Lambert omitted to disclose material facts to investors, including but not limited to the following:
 - a. In May, 2001, Direct Merchants Credit Card Bank docketed a judgment against Lambert for \$8940.64 in Chippewa County Case No. 2001-CV-000074, which he satisfied on March 20, 2002.

- b. In June, 2003, The Northwestern Bank filed a foreclosure action on a mortgage taken by Lambert and his company Diversified Trade Services LLC (“DTS”), in which a default judgment was taken on September 12, 2005, and a sheriff’s sale was confirmed on December 19, 2005 in Rusk County Case No. 03-CV-000068.
 - c. In April, 2004, Lyman Lumber received a judgment against Lambert and DTS for \$34,057.68 in Rusk County Case No. 2003-CV-000107, which was docketed in May, 2004 and satisfied on July 12, 2006. In that same action, the judgment docketed by Pella Windows & Doors against Lambert’s company, DTS, for \$16,250.97 remains unsatisfied.
5. The Wisconsin investors have never been repaid their principal invested with Premier, nor have they received interest payments as required in the notes.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

6. The promissory notes sold by Lambert in Premier are securities as defined by Wis. Stat. § 551.02(13)¹.
7. As described in ¶4 above, Respondents violated Wis. Stat. § 551.41(2) when, in connection with the offer and sale of securities to persons in Wisconsin, Lambert omitted to state material facts necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading.

Therefore, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 551.61(2),

IT IS ORDERED THAT:


1. RESPONDENTS, their agents, servants, employees, and every entity and person directly or indirectly controlled or organized by or on behalf of any RESPONDENT, shall cease and desist from making or causing to be made to any person or entity in Wisconsin any further offers or sales of securities unless and until such securities qualify as covered securities or are registered under Wis. Stats. Ch. 551 or successor statute.
2. All exemptions from registration set forth at Wis. Stats. Ch. 551 or successor statute that might otherwise apply to any offer or sale of any security of or by any of the RESPONDENTS, their successors, affiliates, controlling persons, and every entity and person directly or indirectly controlled or organized by or on behalf of any RESPONDENT, are hereby revoked.
3. RESPONDENTS, their agents, servants, employees and every entity and person directly or indirectly controlled or organized by or on behalf of any RESPONDENT, are prohibited from violating Wis. Stats. § 551.501 (2007-08) or successor statute.

Stats. Ch. 551 or successor statute that might otherwise apply to any offer or sale of a security of or by RESPONDENTS.

2. On or about March 25, 2016, I caused a copy of the Order and the Notice of Order issued in the above-captioned case to be posted on the Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions public website, www.wdfi.org¹. Jean Walsh-Josephson - Case No. S-233148(LX) - A Summary Order to Permanently Bar Broker-Dealer Agent Registration and Notice of Proposed Order to Revoke Broker-Dealer Agent Registration was issued against Jean Walsh-Josephson. The Respondent is permanently barred from becoming registered as an agent of a broker-dealer under Wis. Stat. Ch. 551, as the result of her conduct and pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 551.412(4)(e)(5), 551.412(4)(e)(3) and 551.412(4)(m). The Respondent is prohibited from any further violations of Wis. Stat. Ch. 551, from making or causing to be made to any person or entity in Wisconsin any further offers or sales of securities unless and until such securities qualify as covered securities or are registered under Ch. 551, or successor statute, or properly exempted therefrom, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 551.604(1)(a) and (2), and all exemptions from registration set forth in Ch. 551, that may otherwise apply to any sale or offer to sale of securities by Respondent are hereby revoked, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 551.604(1)(b)(2). It is further proposed that a final order revoking the Respondent's broker-dealer agent registration be issued pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 551.412(2) and (7).

Handel and Advisors Insurance Group, LLC d/b/a Senior Advisors Insurance Group - File No. S-234064(EX) - A Summary Order to Cease and Desist including Restitution and Interest was issued pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 551.604 against Gregory P. Handel and his company, Advisors Insurance Group, LLC for violating Wis. Stat. § 551.403(1) when Handel, through Advisors Insurance Group, LLC, acted as an unregistered investment adviser, and for violating Wis. Stat. §§ 551.501(2) and (3) when he made misrepresentations and omitted to state material facts in connection with the sale of securities. The Respondents are ordered to cease and desist from further violating Wis. Stat. Ch. 551 and it is further proposed that a final order, including the payment of restitution and interest to the investor suffering a loss as the result of the violations, be issued against the Respondents, jointly and severally.

Respondents violated Wis. Stat. § 551.412(4)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code § DFI-Sec 5.01 by failing to complete the application for investment adviser registration within 6 months after it was initially received by the Division. The Respondents are ordered to disgorge the advisory fees they collected while unregistered, along with interest calculated at the legal rate prescribed by Wis. Stat. § 138.04.



The Respondents are ordered to cease and desist from offering or selling unregistered securities or those not qualified as federal covered securities. All state law exemptions from registration are revoked and Respondents are prohibited from violating Wis. Stat. Ch. 551 in the future.

Stat. §551.501(2) for omitting to state material facts necessary in order to make the statements, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading. The Respondents also violated various sections of the Wisconsin Administrative Code as it applies to registered investment advisors. Respondents are suspended for 30 calendar days, and shall pay restitution of \$2,521.61.

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

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


